THE OFFICIAL FFL RULE BOOK

RULES OF THE DRAFT

Draft day will be Saturday, the weekend before Labor Day weekend.

Draft will start at 4:30 p.m.

Any player from any position can be selected during all rounds.

Draft order in the first round will be determined by a card draw.

Draft order in the first round will be 1,7,2,8,3,9,4,10,5,11,6,12.

Draft order in the second round will be 12,6,11,5,10,4,9,3,8,2,7,1.

The first six teams will comprise the Eastern Division, the last six teams will be the Western Division.

This sequence will remain the same through 24 rounds.

All teams must draft the following:

- 4 Quarterbacks
- 6 Running Backs
- 6 Wide Receivers
- 2 Tight Ends
- 2 Kickers
- 2 Special Teams
- 2 Defensive Teams

RULES OF THE ROSTER

All teams must have no more or no less than 24 players on their roster. Your weekly line-up must consist of:

- 1 Quarterback
- 2 Running Backs
- 3 Wide Receivers
- 1 Tight End
- 1 Kicker
- 1 Special Team
- 1 Defensive Team

Each team owner must call in their line-up ½ hour before kickoff.

Line-up changes will be accepted up until kickoff.

If there is a Thursday or Saturday game, only those players need to be called in.

If a line-up is not received prior to the deadline, the previous weeks line-up will be used, regardless if some players are not active

that week.

No line-ups will be taken until the entry fee of \$40.00 is paid.

The entry fee in non-refundable should a player decide to quit during the season.

RULES OF FREE WAIVERS, WAIVERS, TRADES.

Free waivers can be made at any time before the kickoff of the first game of the season.

Each team can make 10 waiver moves during the season. When a player is dropped, another team cannot pick him up for five days.

It is each player's responsibility to check the waiver and trade reports to find out about waiver and trade activity.

Each team can make 10 trades. No trades can be made after kickoff of the 15th game of the season.

RULES OF THE POST-SEASON

Playoff Schedule:

Week # 15 1st and 2nd place teams on a bye.
6th and 3rd play – 4th and 5th play.

Week # 16 1st place winner plays winner of 6th and 3rd.
2nd place plays winner of 4th and 5th.

Week # 17 Winners within each division vs each other.

Week # 18 SUPER BOWL!!

NOTE: Ties for playoff positions will be decided as follows:

Head to head to records.

Total points in head to head records.

Total points overall.

Coin toss.

ADJUSTMENTS

NFL players may be drafted to a position for which they are rostered.

*(see special teams).

FFL players may start NFL players in the position they appear on their rosters only.

MULTI POSITION PLAYERS

Multi position players may be started in their current roster position Only.

MPP's may be moved from one position to another on a roster costing one waiver move. The vacancy may be filled with no extra penalty.

An NFL player's franchise points will be scored according to their starting position in accordance with current scoring rules.

MPP's who are reduced to a singular position by their NFL team will be forced to that position on an FFL roster at the cost of one waiver move. However, any MPP returned to double or triple duty by their NFL team may be repositioned on an FFL roster at no cost to the FFL player.

SPECIAL TEAMS

NFL players who are kick return specialists only are rare, therefore, any player may be drafted into special teams.

Special teams players may be started in special teams only.

Any NFL player on your roster may be started in special teams.

Special teams players score only special teams points.
